

ARPA FUNDING ALLOCATIONS

Boozhoo Gaa-Miskwaabikaang! Red Cliff Tribal Leadership and Staff continue to plan and allocate American Rescue Plan Act funding based on community feedback. The Tribal Council recently approved several ARPA allocations towards Elderly Housing and Road Improvement projects.

ELDERLY HOUSING

On Thursday September 28, 2023, the Red Cliff Tribal Council approved \$2.5M from American Rescue Plan Act funding for an Elderly Housing project. This includes previous Council approval of \$2.5M from ARPA Local Assistance & Tribal Consistency funding for a total project budget of \$5M. The purpose of this project is to construct a new elderly housing complex with 12 apartmentstyle units. The project team's next steps will be working with an architect and engineering firm to engage the community in design and site criteria.

ROADS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

On Thursday September 14, 2023, the Red Cliff Tribal Council approved \$4,000,000 from American Rescue Plan Act funding for Roads Improvement Projects. The project consists of priority one and priority two roads, and includes repaving, new blacktop paving, sidewalks, lighting, and other safety features where necessary and feasible.

Priority one roads include Daley Road, Bineshii Drive, Moccasin Road, North Bradum Road, Buffalo Road, Acorn Road, Bishop Loop, Butterfield Farm Road, Aiken Road, Raspberry Campground Road, and Raspberry Bridge to Sand Bay Road. Priority two roads include Bear Paw Road, Woodland Road, Raspberry Drive, and Frog Bay Road. Both lists do not indicate the order in which they will be completed. In addition, the Chicago Creek culvert is being replaced, and Blueberry Road will be repaved with BIA and Great Lakes Restoration Initiative funding.
