Legendary Waters Resort and Casino Closure

- March 18, 2020

The Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Chippewas recognizes the grave consequences that disease can have upon populations as well as the seriousness of the current global pandemic from the novel coronavirus referred to as COVID-19.

For the safety of our employees, patrons, and community we have voluntarily elected to shut-down the Legendary Waters Resort & Casino at midnight tomorrow, Thursday, March 19, 2020 until Sunday, April 5, 2020. We will be closely monitoring this rapidly developing situation and recognize that further changes to this timeframe may be needed.

Until the specified closing time, we are implementing measures to safeguard employees and patrons such as enhanced cleaning operations, cancelling group events, facilitating social distancing between customers at tables and machines, and modifying food operations. We remind patrons and employees alike to be responsible and not come to our facilities if you are ill.

In thinking about the well-being of our affected employees and their families, they will be provided two weeks' pay based on the most current previous pay periods.

While most casinos are located in areas that are not currently identified hot spots for infection, we recognize that pre-emptive action is useful to help flatten the curve of infection rates so that COVID-19 can be managed by the existing health care system.

We continue to work with all of our partners on the tribal, federal, state, and local levels to be responsive to COVID-19 and the related public health issues as a sovereign nation to ensure we are doing all we can to keep our community safe.
